You may find the following checklist helpful when thinking about questions to ask the clinical trials team. The answers, which will vary according to your situation and the trial you are considering, should help you to decide whether or not to take part, and assist you to make an informed decision.

What costs are involved in the trial?		
Where will the treatment take place? For example, will it be in a clinic?		
Will I have to be hospitalised?		
What are the possible side effects?		
How will the treatment affect me emotionally?		
How will the treatment affect me physically?		
Is the information collected about me confidential?		
What happens if I change my mind about participating in the trial?
