Are you interested in undertaking post graduate study towards a Palliative Care qualification? If so, Cancer Council WA invites you to apply for a McLarty Palliative Care Scholarship. McLarty Palliative Care Scholarships are awarded to Registered Nurses and Allied Health Professionals who seek to improve knowledge, skills and clinical practice in palliative care through the completion of Post Graduate Certificates, Post Graduate Diplomas and Masters in Palliative Care.

Eligibility Criteria

All applicants must be:

- A registered nurse or allied health professional employed in WA
- An Australian citizen or have permanent residency status at the time of application
- Enrolling or enrolled in a course that leads to an accredited tertiary qualification with a Palliative Care focus
- Willing to submit a report following the scholarship and participate in scholarship evaluation
- Able to submit the completed application form and enclose copies of relevant documentation
