Bowel cancer is the second biggest cancer killer in Australia. Screening is the best way of finding this cancer early. We need more people to do the screening test, to help save more lives. It is important to do the screening kit when it arrives in your mailbox.

GRANTS OVERVIEW

Cancer Council WA is offering up to \$200 for multicultural community groups to have a community event which brings people together, and also learn about bowel cancer screening.

Target group

- 50 to 74 years, because older people are more likely to get bowel cancer.
- People from multicultural backgrounds, because it is important for everyone to know about and do the free screening test when it arrives in your mailbox.

About your event

Your event should:

- be in the Perth metro area
- reach 50 to 74 year olds
- reach a multicultural community
- include an activity. Be creative! Some healthy activity ideas include:
 - » healthy morning or afternoon tea
 - » yoga or meditation
 - » exercise
 - » a quiz or game
 - » arts and crafts
- include a bowel cancer session presented by Cancer Council WA

Your grant cannot be used for:

- alcohol or events where alcohol will be present
- individuals
- unhealthy catering

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

- Email your application form** before Monday 31 August 2020. Cancer Council WA will contact you within 3 weeks of the closing date.
- Hold your community event** before June 2021.
- Email your completed event report** along with an **invoice and receipts** from your community event. You will then receive up to \$200 to cover the costs from your community event.
